# 5. <u>Presentation</u> (A. Ooms)

Ann Ooms described the project, its aims, participants and processes. Mary Stuart invited questions and comments from the group.

#### Discussion followed around:

- Mary Stuart mentioned an article that was published in the Times Higher Education edition regarding the use of mobile phones for in-classroom feedback.
- It was noted that an additional participant from FASS is needed for this project.
- There needs to be clear understanding of summative versus formative assessment both students and participants need to understand the connection.
- Participants will use the technologies to the extent that it is relevant. A whole range of technologies will be available.

- Mixed method methodology will be used. Data will be collected through questionnaires, interviews, focus groups, reflective journals, logbook, classroom observations, assessment data, and attendance data.
- Reflective journal: it was decided that a questionnaire would be used to record participants' reflections after each session. This would allow for sharing of experiences among participants and would enable Ann Ooms to send a reminder the participants to completing the reflective journals. Additional data will be obtained through interviews.
- Feedback from participants on the success/failure of technology uses will be shared.
- Additional research questions:
  - The question of whether teaching practices have improved.
  - There should be a research question to compare results with mobile technology vs. without mobile technology.
  - There should be a research question on levels of interaction with/out before/after technology.
- Data should be collected about previous delivery of course without mobile technology.
